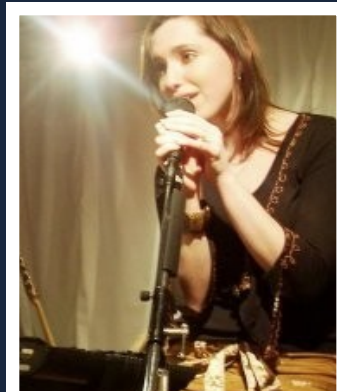

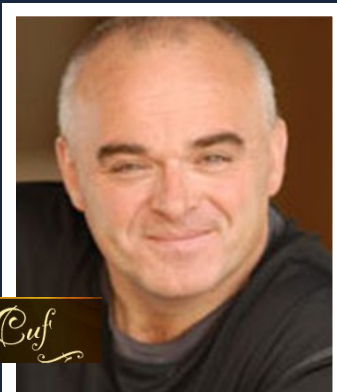
Revelation Band

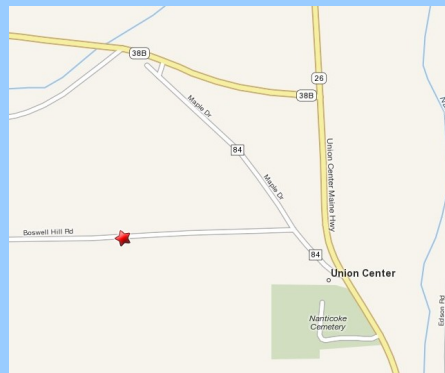

SESSIONS

SESSION 1 CHOICES

1A Make-up & Beyond*

A hands-on class in creating make-up for special characters, from animals to aliens...as well as an opportunity to learn how to apply make-up for aging characters.

1B Acting 101— Basics

The successful blending of basic acting techniques and interpretation to initiate and understand the character you are trying to create.

1C Improv I

An introduction to basic theatre games that will encourage unity, strengthen cooperation, and teach the art of team building. Using their intellect and imagination, attendees are taken thru both verbal and non-verbal games that are interactive and fun.

SESSION 2 CHOICES

2A Characterization Through Costuming

Learn to depict various visual traits of assorted characters, the thought processes behind our perceptions, and how we start to apply this to costume projects, including hands-on class creations.

2B Hands On-Stage Craft

Creating those special stage pieces you need for your production including building and creating a few ideas of our own in the class.

2C Improv II

In case you missed the first one (Improv I), we wanted to give everyone an opportunity to catch this class with Colin and Dave...you won't want to miss the fun!

3A Costume Craft & Accessorizing *

Creating a basic ladies bonnet from the 1870's without a sewing machine or hat making experience, with step by step instruction. Everyone should leave with a completed hat.

3B Behind the Scenes— Tech

Everything you ever wanted to know: from lights, sound, colors, and effects to make your technical elements work better for your production.

3C From Character to Characterization
