The Speaker:

Full conference packages include the conference, a light snack Friday evening, 3 meals on Saturday and brunch on Sunday, as well as lodging. Early registrants (those registering before December 31st) can save \$15 off the registration cost. A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is due with registration, with the balance due in February.
